This working forest is sustainably managed by professional foresters using science-based techniques to produce timber, protect water quality and provide wildlife habitat across the landscape.

Previous Rotation:

- Clearcut: 1983
- Planted: 1985
- Clearcut: 2010

Current Rotation:

- Clearcut: 2010
- Replanting: 2013
- First Thinning: 2040
- Second Thinning: 2049
- Clearcut and replanting: 2060

Wood harvested from this stand was used to build homes in the Northeast and make paper and other products.

At all stages of its growth, this forest serves as important habitat for wildlife.
